**Candidate Information for CITA Administered ADEX Dental Examinations**

The intent of the information contained within this document is to assist the candidate with taking the Council of Interstate Testing Agencies (CITA) administered ADEX licensure examination. The information, policies and fee structure contained herein are formulated solely by the administration of the ECU School of Dental Medicine. **Parking:**

Patient and candidate parking is available across from the main entrance of the school located at 1851 MacGregor Downs Road, Greenville, North Carolina 27834. Handicapped parking is available directly in front of the building on MacGregor Downs Road. There is no fee for parking.

**Facility Usage Fee:**

The fee that is submitted by the candidate to CITA on behalf of the ECU School of Dental Medicine pays for the direct costs of hosting the examination. The fee includes the use of the facilities, support staff, and the following equipment, instruments, and supplies.

**Use of Facility/Facility Tour:**

Candidates who wish to view the school's facilities prior to the examination must contact the Office of Clinical Affairs at (252) 737-7110 no later than the deadline outlined below. A brief tour of the facility will be scheduled for interested candidates the afternoon prior to the examination, time to be announced. ***The facility may not be used to screen patients, do preparatory work, or take radiographs prior to the examination due to demands on staff and liability reasons.*** Candidates should complete these activities at their own facility prior to arriving for the examination.

Smoking is not permitted within the School of Dental Medicine. Food and beverages are *NOT* permitted in clinic reception or any clinic care area at any time! Please be certain that your patients and assistants are informed of these rules. No one other than the candidate, an assistant pre-registered with CITA, and the candidate's patients will be allowed in our facility on the examination days.

**Access to Facility:**

You will be allowed to enter the ECU School of Dental Medicine after 6:00 am. Please use the MacGregor Downs Road entrance. Candidates will not be allowed in the clinics until after registration is completed. The ECU School of Dental Medicine will be locked at 7 pm.

**Instruments and Sterilization:**

Candidates who wish to rent instruments from the school will need to contact Ms. Twila Lye at (252) 737-7056 or email: [Lyet@ecu.edu](mailto:Lyet@ecu.edu) beginning the week prior to the examination. ***Candidates should not call or email before the designated time frame outlined below as your request will not be granted.*** Please do not call the CITA office regarding instrument rental and/or sterilization. You must contact the ECU School of Dental Medicine directly. **Please only email the week of the exam** Since ECU will be busy preparing for the exam.

Candidates who do not rent instruments are required to have their instruments sterilized at the School, even if your instruments have been sterilized previously! Candidates must contact Ms. Twila Lye at (252) 737-7056 or email: [Lyet@ecu.edu](mailto:Lyet@ecu.edu) during the week prior to the examination between 9:00 am and noon or 2:00 pm and 4:30 pm to make reservations to drop off instruments for sterilization. ***All instruments to be sterilized at ECU School of Dental Medicine must be turned in to the sterilization department between 8 am and 10 am two days prior to the scheduled examination.***

***Candidates should not call or email before the above dates as your request will not be granted.***

**Storage of Instruments and Supplies:**

You are reminded that there are no provisions for storing instruments, equipment, supplies, or personal belongings at the School, either overnight OR during the day. If you leave items at the School during the examination period, you do so at your own risk!

### **Screening Patients and radiographs:**

The ECU School of Dental Medicine does not assume any responsibility for supplying patients for the licensure examination and cannot assist in finding patients. The School is NOT available for screening patients and obtaining radiographs for screening purposes. Additionally the ECU School of Dental Medicine is not involved with any proprietary service that provides patients for licensing examinations and will not allow any non-ECU student candidate search for patients in the School's patient population. If a CITA examiner requests a radiograph be taken, there is a **\$16** fee for each radiograph. ***The candidate will be responsible for payment of this fee at the time the radiograph is taken. Candidates may pay for radiographs by cash or credit card (MasterCard/Visa/American Express).***

***Digital radiographs must be printed for this exam location per the ADEX patient manual. If you are providing traditional (non-digital radiographs) you must supply your own view box.***

## Instruments and Supplies

The instruments contained herein are available from the ECU School of Dental Medicine. *\*It is strongly suggested that if the candidate is accustomed to certain instruments, supplies/materials or burs not referenced herein that he/she bring such instruments, supplies/materials or burs with them to the examination to avoid the obvious additional stress of working with unfamiliar equipment.*

### Dental Chairs:

The ECU School of Dental Medicine uses ADEC Model 511 chairs with radius style light and delivery system that adapts to both right and left handed providers.

### Dental Units

Dental units at the ECU School of Dental Medicine are equipped with Adec fiber optic hoses with quick disconnects. Both air driven and electric options are present.
